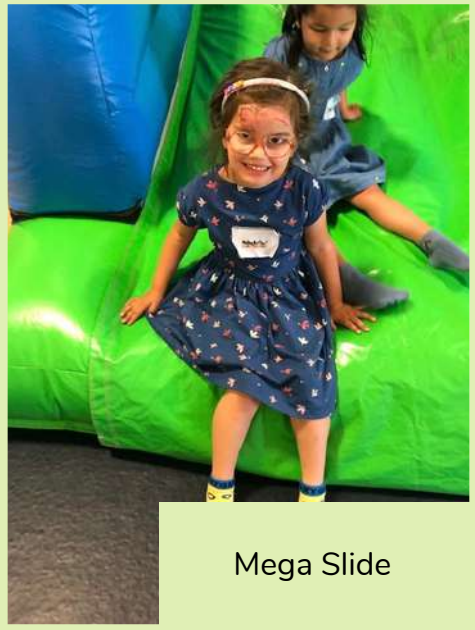

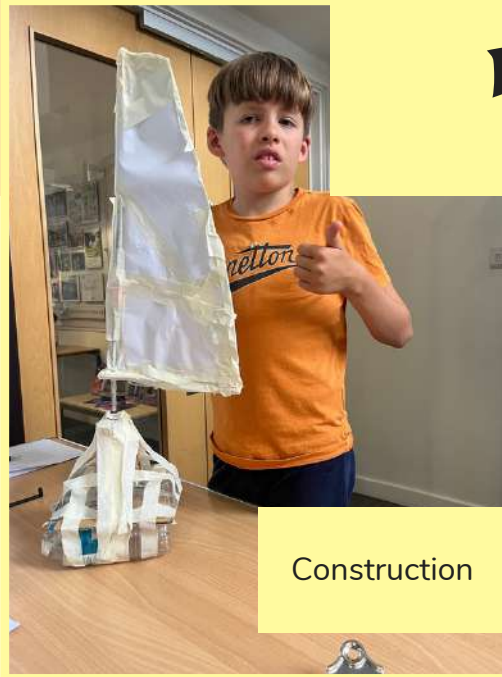

A Creative Workshop on Loneliness

We are looking for young people aged 8-24 years to take part in an **Arts Workshop** for a research project on Youth **Loneliness**

Researchers at Queen Mary University are looking to learn more about what loneliness means to young people, so that we can develop a new questionnaire to measure youth loneliness.

To do this we are hosting arts workshops where your child will be asked to take part in artistic activities to express their thoughts and feelings about loneliness. Separate workshops will be held for different age groups (8-9, 10-11, 12-15, 16-18, and 19-24 years).

By taking part your child will have the opportunity to meet other young people of a similar age from your city. They will also be helping to make sure young people who are experiencing loneliness get the right support in the future.

The workshops will take place in **August 2023** at a Queen Mary University or local arts organization venue, and will be run by artists from People's Palace Projects, an organization that use creativity and collaboration to make positive change within communities.

As a thank-you for taking part you/your child will be offered a £40 voucher, even if they decide to leave before the end of the session.
